**2016 TOWNSEND AWARD FOR OVER 30 YEARS OF SERVICE TO FIRST BAPTIST**

The Townsend Award was established on behalf of our senior minister, Dr. John H. Townsend. The award highlights his exemplary service for over 35 years at First Baptist Church. Our recipient has many stories that she tells about her life when she joined under his ministry.



As a teenager she became a member in 1970. She participated in all youth activities, developing her leadership skills. Later she served as President of College and Career Council, Co-principal of the Primary Department of our Church School, and Social chairman of the Youth Council. She performed an excellent job as Social Chairman and has a wealth of stories and tales from those years.

Later as an adult, Christian Education became her focus. She served on the Board of Christian Education which is still a part of her Christian life. In her role as a Vacation Bible School leader and Church School teacher, her natural talent of getting the children to sing and share their stories during worship has brought joy to the Church. In 2007 she re-

ceived the Arlo R. Reichter Award for her dedication to Christian Education.

Singing is her passion so she has participated in the choir, praise teams and the Gospel ensembles throughout her time at First Baptist. In 1982 she married her husband, Kenneth and out of this union, one son, Kenneth, Jr., was born. He is also a member of First Baptist.
